

Variety NT Community Grants Application Process

About Variety NT: Variety Northern Territory (Variety NT) believes in giving all kids a fair go. Our Community Grants aim to support organisations directly working with children in the Northern Territory who are disadvantaged, sick or living with a disability. We're committed to fostering inclusion and equality within our community to help kids reach their full potential.

Eligibility:

Organisations are eligible to apply for a grant provided they:

- Are a school, community group, not-for-profit (NFP) or non-governmental organisation (NGO) working with children aged 0-17 facing disadvantages, illnesses, or living with a disabilities.
- Demonstrate that funding is not available through Government or alternative sources.

Application Process

- 1. **Submit Online Application:** Complete and submit an application form with all supporting documentation, including financial details and relevant evidence.
- 2. **Pre-Assessment:** Your application will be pre-assessed by our team at Variety NT. We will contact you if your application does not meet the criteria or needs additional information, before proceeding to the next stage.
- **3. Review:** The Kids Support Committee, which includes qualified professionals, will review your submission.
- **4. Outcome:** You will receive an outcome via email following assessment by Variety NT.

Request & Funding Information

- Funding of up to \$15,000 can be requested.
- Requested items must directly benefit the children linked with your organisation, promoting inclusion and equality.

 Funding is for physical items or resources only, such as equipment or resources for hire or purchase.

Ineligible Requests

- · Administration and salary expenses
- Therapy or rehabilitation
- Research
- Capital Works
- Services
- Retrospective expenses
- Travel costs or vehicle rental
- Catering
- Excursions

Additional Information

- Variety NT Community Grants are typically open between January and November, with current information available on the Variety NT website.
- Outcomes are generally communicated within 6 weeks but may take up to 3 months depending on demand.
- Approved outcomes are not guaranteed, and contributions may be offered in lieu of full funding at Variety NT's discretion.

Outcome

- Successful applicants will receive full details and next steps in their outcome letter.
- Funds must be used within 6 months of approval.
- Variety NT does not provide funds directly; payment is made via tax invoice to the supplier.
- Unsuccessful applicants will not receive reasons for rejection, and outcomes cannot be appealed.

Post-Submission and Assessment

- Submissions are pre-assessed by our team at Variety NT, presented to the Kids Support Committee (KSC), and then to the Board of Directors for final decision.
- Successful applicants must return the signed funding agreement to Variety NT before funds are disbursed.
- Applicants are required to report against funding agreement outcomes within 12 months.

Publicity and Acknowledgment

- Variety NT may share details of successful projects for marketing purposes.
- Recipients are expected to publicly acknowledge Variety NT's support.

- Variety NT may organise media launches or events for successful projects.
- The organisation's assistance with content and images will be appreciated. Written permission will be needed for any use of children's and participants' images.
