Friends of Windamere was formed in 1991 and provides day option services to intellectually disabled young people. Each day they transport all of their clients to and from the Farm in Buckland Park, as no public transport is available. With the generous support from Argoweld, Variety SA granted \$78,000 towards a 22 seat Sunshine Coach to replace one of their older buses and a van that are about to be retired due to age and condition. With this new set of wheels they can continue to generously support young South Australian's in need!
