Variety SA team members along with David from Adelaide Vehicle Centre conducted an official key hand over after presenting this new vehicle to members of the school staff and student body.

Woodville High School caters for 1,000 students, including 25 in special classes. These students have a range of physical and intellectual disabilities. A Sunshine Coach will support the Community Access Program for the students in the special classes, aimed at preparing them for independent living as adults.



Sensory room at Adelaide East Education Centre

A new \$33,000 Variety SA funded sensory room has been installed at Adelaide East Education Centre to help calm students with intellectual disabilities, encouraging them to develop a range of senses through visual and audio stimulis. Its introduction has improved student behaviour, leaving the children less prone to outbursts.
