

Criteria

- Applicants must;
- live in South Australia
- be aged up to 18 years

Depending on your application there may be other criteria.

How to apply

As part of your application some supporting documents will be required. These may differ between grant programs, but generally include:

- Child's diagnosis ie letter from a GP or Paediatrician
- Financial documents ie recent payslips and/or Centrelink statements
- Quote related to requested item/s
- Support letter related to item requested ie: from an occupational therapist, physiotherapist, social worker or other relevant professional
