FACEBOOK EVENTS

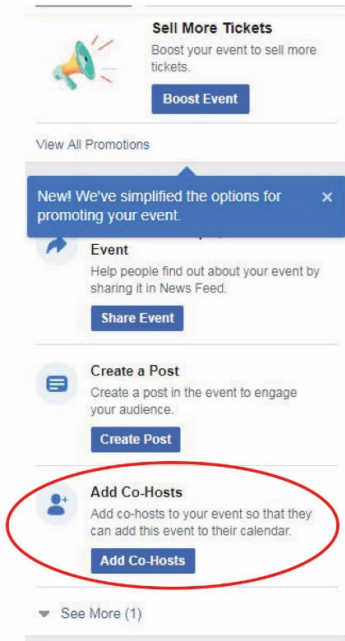

1. Car 10 (Raising funds for the SA Variety Bash)
2. Car 10 (Raising funds for kids in need through the SA Variety Bash)
3. Car 10 (an entrant in the 2020 SA Variety Bash)

DO NOT USE

- The Variety Logo - (It must be the Bash Logo)
- Do not use terms "Variety Club", "Bashing" or "Bush Bashing"

PAYMENT OPTIONS

1. Credit Card Online via your Raisely Fundraising Page.

- Type the Bash Car Number into the search box.

2. Credit Card Online via the Variety website

- Click Submit. You will be taken to the secure payment page, where you can enter your Visa, MasterCard or Amex details.

3. Westpac Smart ATM Deposit

You can deposit all fundraising monies into a Westpac Smart ATM by using our bank account and your mobile phone numbers [CLICK HERE](#) to see how easy it is.

COLLECTION TINS

We have collection tins available from the Variety Office, please provide a some notice on how many tins you require and we can have them ready for you.

BANKING - Collection Tins

Once your tins are full take them to a Westpac Coin Banking Machine and you can bank the money into our Bank Account below;

You will receive a confirmation receipt, if you take a photo of the receipt and email it to finance@variety.org.au your funds will be allocated to your fundraising statement as easy as that!

BANK ACCOUNTS

Bash entrants must not create bank accounts with any of the following names; Variety, Variety Bash, Bash Car or anything similar to hold money raised for Variety.

TRANSFERRING FUNDS TO YOUR BASH CAR

A reminder to tell all donors and supporters when transferring funds into our bank account to make sure they reference **Bash20M/Your car No.**

Then email all details to Tanya via finance@variety.org.au and what the payment is for to ensure the funds are allocated to your fundraising balance and receipted correctly.

DONATION VS SPONSORSHIP

DONATION is a voluntary payment, for which the donor receives nothing of value in return. This means that tickets to functions, raffle tickets, auction items etc are not donations because something of value is received in return for the payment.

SPONSORSHIP is a payment, for which advertising or marketing benefits are received. As an example, the sponsor may receive signage on your Bash Car. If they receive a small sticker on the car up to (30cm x 10cm) then it is not considered 'of value' and the payment can be treated as a donation. However if the sticker is larger than (30cm x 10cm) this becomes sponsorship which includes GST, so the funds credited to the team fundraising statement will be net of GST.

INVOICES

Many organisations require an invoice to make a donation/payment towards your fundraising. To request an invoice please email the amount, company name, contact person, email address and your Bash car number to Tanya via tanya@variety.org.au

DEPOSIT CARDS

Selected Westpac branches now have the facilities to accept new self service deposit cards.

We can issue you a self service deposit card which will be linked to your Bash fundraising account via the Variety Bank Account.

This card is similar to an ATM card (with no PIN required) and you use it when depositing funds raised into our bank account.

SQUARE



Square is a small device you can purchase which allows you to accept tap-and-go credit card donations/payments anywhere anytime, and the money goes straight into the Variety bank account.

This is an easy system that you can use at any fundraiser or even when collecting donations whilst rattling the collection tin, giving people the opportunity to donate even if they don't have cash on them.

We recommend the \$59 version and you can purchase these devices through either Officeworks or Harvey Norman and we can help you set it up.

Other fundraising options

WORKPLACE GIVING

What will you give?

The message in our 'Workplace Giving' campaign is simple. For as little as \$2 per week, an individual can make a real difference to the life of a child in SA.

By signing up your organisation's employees to Variety's Workplace Giving Program, donations received from your organisation and individuals can be attributed to a chosen Bash vehicle, not only helping your car's fundraising tally but helping kids in need in SA!
