Introduction

The purpose of this emergency response plan is to provide our event Officials and Workshops with a clear and easy to follow manual for use during an incident. This document should be included in the event bible and should be easily accessible in the event of critical incident.

The Event Manager, Event Chairman review this document prior to each event.

Roles and Responsibility

Role of Communications Team RAD1 - Incident Control

- Request OV10, OV11 & OV12 to scene
- Locate and request closest other OV to assist
- Locate and request closest other MW to assist
- If patient extrication is anticipated, ensure MW1 with Jaws of Life is deployed
- Establish if incident is within mobile phone coverage and use mobile phone if possible.
- Establish an Incident Channel on HF Radio
- If event vehicles are required to move backwards on track, ensure all OV/MW's STOP and Hold all other entry vehicles at their current position.
- Locate nearest evacuation point for patients, should transfer of patients be necessary (eg airstrip)
- Make 000 call once specific location has been obtained by GPS coordinates
- All radio communication with the scene will be through the non-medical OV
- Liaise with Event Chairman as required.
- Roll call for update of all OV and MW locations
- Instruct all OV and MW teams to HOLD current position or proceed to a specific **KM Position**.
- Ensure OV/MW advise that request has been actioned, ensure one official waits by radio for further instruction if required.

Role of Event Chairman OVI

- RAD1 will provide regular updates to the Event Chairman.
- Event Chairman and Route Director should advise RAD1 to instruct Officials to HOLD current position, proceed to a specific position and HOLD, Or continue with caution.
- Ensure other entrants are not at further risk by planning and communicating any controls or detours as required.
- The Event entrants are the main priority for the Event Chairman.
- Communication to event entrants should be as informative as possible with the reason given, "Officials are responding to incident and they are required to move backwards on the track. We will advise of further instructions as required"

Role of Medical Team at Scene – OV10/OV11/OV12

At least one medical vehicle to attend all incidents (if more medical vehicles required RAD1 will advise)

- Identify triage and treat injured
- Early assessment of requirements for other services that may be required (eg cutting equipment or Jaws of life from MW1)
- Early assessment of likely need for patient evacuation to medical facility
- Liaise with non-medical OV for communications with RAD1
- If direct contact with 000 or RFDS or medical facility is required, this is to be done through direct liaison with RAD1.

Role of Official Team at Scene

The first Non-medical OV on the scene will be responsible for ensuring the following are attended to:

- Ensuring safety at scene (eg if necessary diverting event traffic)
- All radio communication to and from the scene (one person to remain in the vehicle)
- Ensuring all event traffic continues past the scene, unless specific assistance is required
- Ensure OV10/OV11/OV12 vehicles have enough room and easy access to the scene
- Locate and communicate GPS Reference, km mark and or closest intersection to RAD 1
- Liaising with OV10/OV11/OV12 re requirements for patient transport
- If assistance is required for patient transport, appropriate event vehicles should be seconded for this purpose.
- Arranging for transport of any personal belongings that are not going to continue
- If patient evacuation is required, ensure someone is available who is familiar and has travelled the route to the evacuation site
- Provide regular updates to RAD1 on a secure frequency

Role of Workshop Team at Scene – MW

The first MW to arrive on the scene will be responsible for ensuring the following are attended to:

- Respond to scene, if more MW/ Support vehicles are required RAD1 will advise.
- Early assessment of requirements for specialised equipment such as Jaws of Life or further services that are required
- If Jaws of Life are required, RAD1 will request MW1 to scene.
- Patient wellbeing is the first priority, once this is established; MW should turn their attention to the vehicle.
- In the case of a vehicle crash, disconnect the battery, manage any fuel spills and secure any un-deployed air bags, if present.
- Vehicle should be assessed as to whether it can safely continue the event with repair, or if it needs to be towed (or unable to be towed).
- If the vehicle is unable to be repaired, MW crews are to remove all associated decals from the vehicle and RAD 1 will arrange for external services to collect the vehicle.

Role of Official and Workshop Teams Not at location of Incident:

Official and MW Crews should maintain their traveling position and when requested, advise RAD 1 of their location.

Official Vehicles with assistance of MW's, will be responsible for ensuring the following are attended to:

- Establish your current location, km mark
- At the request of RAD 1, OVs may be asked to HOLD ALL Traffic at their current location or continue to a specific location and HOLD event.
- Advise RAD1 when instruction has been actioned.
- Communication to event entrants should be as informative as possible with the reason given, "Officials are responding to incident and they are required to move backwards on the track. We will advise of further instructions as required"
- One Official should remain in vehicle by the radio at all times in case of further instructions.

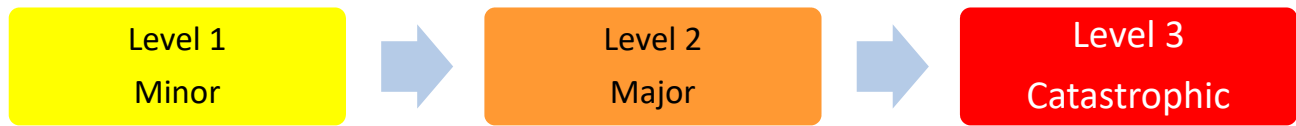
Dealing with the Media

ALL comments to the media will ONLY be made via the Event Chairman or person appointed by the CEO.

All other OV's and support crews WILL NOT make any comment to any other parties. If comment is unavoidable, it must only be of a favourable nature, and must convey the impression that the event is running well. If you are asked about a particular incident that may show the event in an unfavourable light, inform the parties involved that you are unaware of the situation, and tell them to contact the Event Chairman.

HF Radio Emergency Procedure

In the event of an incident, have one Official stay with the radio at all times and follow 5 steps below.

Radio RAD 1 : **RAD1, RAD1 this is OV number - await response -**
 RAD1 this is OV number at the following LOCATION, (KM or GPS)
 Requiring URGENT SUPPORT from a medical OV and workshop.

FIRST ON SCENE

If you are, first on scene at an incident the suggested procedure to follow is:

(If other entrants are on the scene already, ensure on Official or MW take control of the scene. Clear scene of all unrequired people/entrants. **ASSESS DANGER TO SELF THEN OTHERS.**

Prior to leaving your vehicle, give RAD1 your location and radio your Car no and location as per below:

Crew Member 1

1. One Official member to remain in the vehicle close to the radio to await response and information.
2. You will be the central contact point between RAD1 and incident scene.
3. Upon arrival of a second official vehicle, allocate tasks such as traffic control, bystander management and maintain a level of control of the incident.

Crew Member 2 (ONLY IF IT IS NOT COMPROMISING YOUR OWN SAFETY)

1. Ensure safety at scene
(eg if on a corner or poorly visible spot, stop next vehicle and ask them to control traffic)
2. Assess condition of the casualty as Injury or Illness
3. Apply First Aid to your level of training, DRABC.

DANGER
RESPONSE
AIRWAY
BREATHING
CIRCULATION

It is important to only move the casualty if there is a direct threat to their safety.

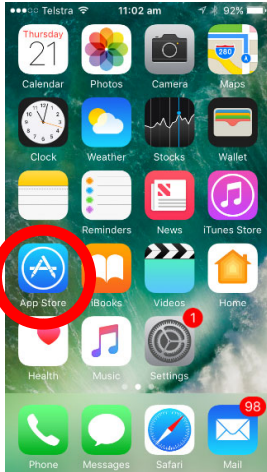
4. Check airway is clear. If appropriate, place casualty on their side in recovery position or maintain head/spine control if necessary. Apply pressure to any bleeding wounds.
5. Return to your vehicle and update RAD1 of any changes in response, condition or requirements for further assistance. Never leave casualties unattended.
6. Return to the occupants and again reassure, advising them that assistance is on its way.
7. All you can really do from a medical perspective is to ensure airways are clear and stem bleeding; again, reassurance is your most important role and management of bystanders and their safety at the scene.

POST INCIDENT

Level 1 & 2 Incidents

Post incidents of threshold 1 or 2, should be debriefed as part of evening official meetings and the key learnings implemented in a timely manner. Where applicable these incidents should also be revisited at the post event debrief.

Level 3 Incidents

Threshold 3 Incidents should be debriefed with the Event Management team consisting of:

- Event Chairman

- The Variety CEO

- The Variety Event Manager

- The Variety SA Chairman or member of the Board

- All officials and workshop crews should be invited.

This debrief should occur as soon as possible post incident with learnings revisited at the post event debrief.

In the event of a critical incident, Variety will arrange counselling and debrief service for all entrants and public directly involved with the incident. This will take place at a time convenient during the event.

UHF RADIOS

Our most important role is to uphold the reputation and integrity of the event and the Variety brand. We must set a good example.

UHF radio protocol should be the call sign of the person you are calling followed by your own call sign

Eg. "Car 41 this is OV1, do you receive? – await response.

A UHF radio with external antenna is required to be fitted to every vehicle and be in good working order and if a radio is not working, it must be repaired by RAD 2.

UHF radio is for safety reasons and must not be used as general chitchat. Under no circumstances should there be controversial conversation and there is a zero tolerance to bad language.

Radio Protocol

N.B. As with UHF channels, radio etiquette is to be used at all times i.e. no swearing

All communication and messages are to be directed to RAD 1. If RAD 1 is unable to respond, RAD 2 will respond on their behalf.

Correct Radio Protocol is:

- Listen for any traffic on the channel. If the channel is busy, wait unless you have an urgent message.
- Announce your callsign to RAD1

Eg. RAD 1, RAD 1, this is your call sign. – await response.

- RAD 1 will acknowledge your call or ask you to standby if they are busy.
- If no response is received, you can try a higher channel close to mid-day, or down a channel early morning or night time.
- RAD 1 monitors all 4 channels at once and therefore may be busy on another.
- If still unable to raise RAD 1, Send a message acknowledging no response and your message RAD1 will most likely be able to hear you, even if you can't hear them.

Eg RAD 1, RAD 1, This is your callsign, NO RESPONSE FROM RAD 1 MESSAGE IS AS FOLLOWS ... and Repeat.

When to call RAD1

You are required to inform RAD 1 during these situations so they are able to keep track of your position and the field.

- Departing Checkout- This is best to call in at the 2km mark once you are clear of the town and powerlines.
- Every 1 hour or 50km – Update of your current KM Marker
- If you come across a vehicle requiring assistance
- If all passengers are leaving the vehicle (eg. fun stop or lunch stop) you must advise RAD1 of your movements.
- If you have a passenger that is not an official – You may be asked to place your radio on selcall mute by pressing the (7) Key. You are still required to update RAD 1 as per normal.
- If you depart the route to travel direct – you must then update your position regularly using towns or landmarks such as intersections.
- Arriving at Check In – again best to call in 2km out of town.
- Any messages that need to be passed on can be done at any time.
- If there are oncoming vehicles that may present a danger to event traffic
- If there is a Police Presence checking speed or drink driving, RAD 1 should be notified
eg "RAD1 this is OV1 at 120km Mark and there are Police checking speed"
- Use the Emergency Radio Procedure in the event of an incident.

- If you wish to communicate directly to another OV or MW, the request is to go through RAD1 first.

e.g. RAD1, RAD1 this is OV1 requesting to communicate direct with OV11

Remember, they may not be able to hear you so RAD1 or RAD2 will be the relay.

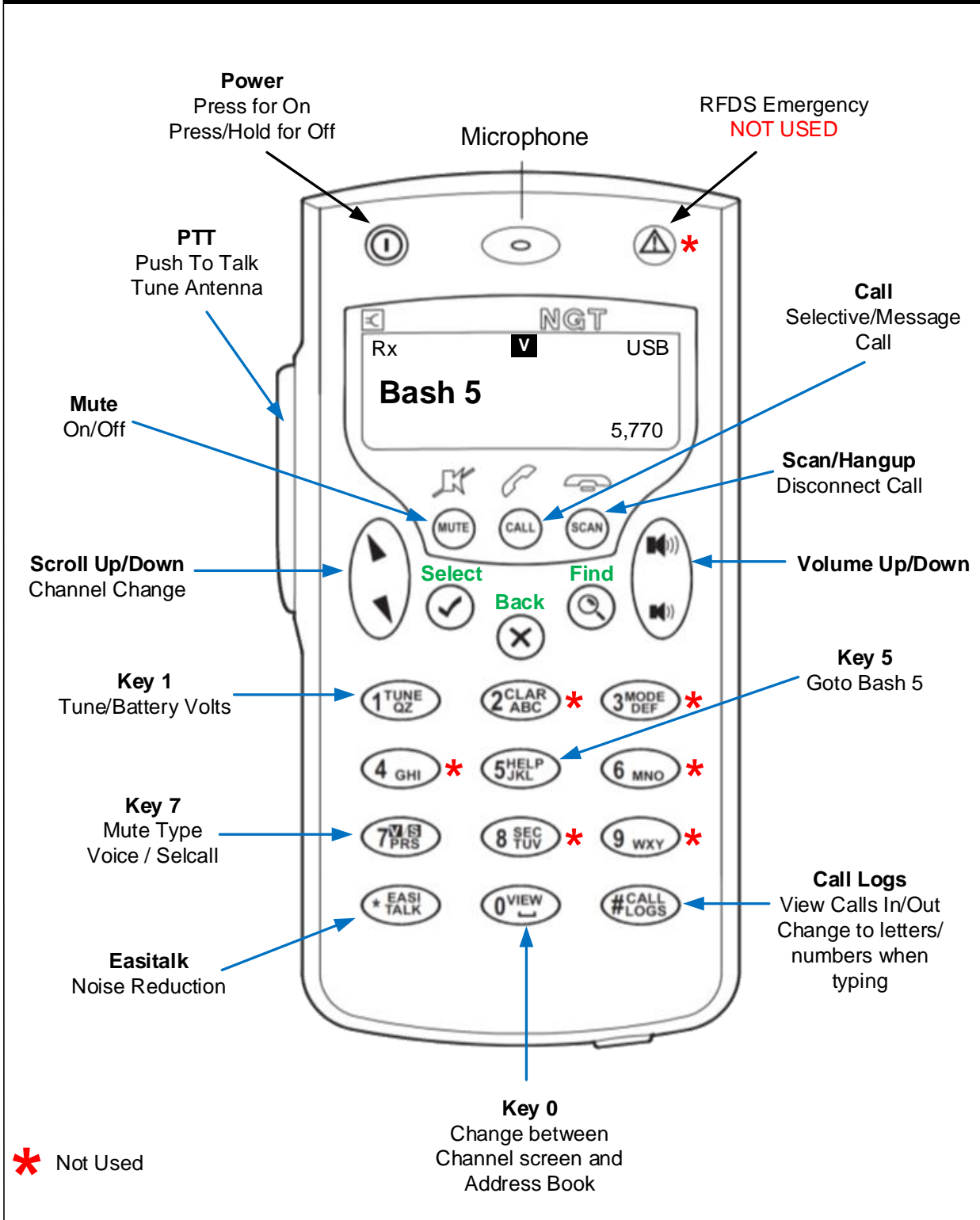

Using your HF Radio

CODAN HF HANDSET:

- To turn ON / OFF press and hold the green button – top left side of the handset.
- After 10 seconds BASH and other numbers appear on the handset screen.
- Use the up and down arrow keys on the face of the handset left side half way down to scroll and select your channel e.g. BASH 3, BASH 4, BASH 5, BASH 6.
- As a rule of thumb higher the sun the higher the channel. **Don't be afraid to change channels from morning to midday to evening if you are having difficulty.**
- Start line you will be informed of the BASH channel you will start the event on at checkout.
- Commence each day here after on the Bash channel you finished the day before. Move your channels as required or if you are having difficulty contacting RAD1 or if requested by RAD1.
- RAD1 will be monitoring 4 channels during the event.
- Your radio must be tuned before you use it or whenever you change channels. To do this simply depress the transmit (PTT) button located on the left hand side of the handset. Your Self-Tune Antenna will complete this process which will take up to 10 seconds. You can now transmit using the PTT button. Your BASH channel will reappear on the screen.
- Please Note – some officials have their self-tuning antennas mounted on the rear right hand side of the vehicle – you may have to re-tune the antenna if you open the rear wagon window. This also reduces the performance of your radio.
- Volume Controls are the speaker symbols on the face of the handset



The volume must always be set to 50% or higher
Don't turn the volume down so you can't hear RAD1

- **Your Radio must always be on Voice Mute** – indicated on the screen as a **V** in a black square – Just depress the Mute button if not on – you can also depress the 7 button which alternates between **V** mute and **S** mute. Your Radio must be on **V** in black square mute and not **S** (selcall) mute unless advised.
- EasiTalk Noise Reduction button – located left hand side bottom of handset (*key), must be 'EasiTalk On'. This setting is automatic on power up of your radio.
- If for some reason you are on a totally foreign screen press PTT to go back to the Channel screen – use the up/down scroll keys to select the correct BASH channel. Re tune aerial.

Part of your official duty is, you must be within earshot of the radio at all times during the day or if you are leaving the vehicle. Call RAD1 and advise of your movements.

HF Radio Interference in Vehicles

Interference and noise from many sources generally only reduces your ability to receive weak HF radio signals. Rarely does it affect your transmissions.

Interference usually originates from vehicle electrical and electronic systems, particularly after-market accessories. Common sources of interference include:

- AC (240V) power inverters
- HID driving lights, LED driving lights and light bars
- Florescent tube and LED camping lights
- Rotating, flashing or strobe warning/emergency light units
- Laptops or tablet PCs
- 12V laptop chargers (e.g. cigarette lighter style or permanently wired units)
- Cigarette lighter USB chargers
- Electric fridges (compressor type, typically not absorption or thermoelectric)
- Electric winches
- DC-DC Converters (especially Redarc units)
- Brake Controller (especially Redarc units)
- Solar Controllers

Not all of these devices always cause interference. It depends on your particular HF radio installation, where cables are routed, where the antenna is installed and the brand of device. Some of these devices may only be used intermittently and will only cause interference while in use. Some may cause interference even if just plugged in and not actually being used.

Interference may sound like buzzing, “hash” or just static. Turn off, unplug, disconnect or pull the fuse on any suspect equipment to see if the interference reduces and your reception improves.

Parking under or next to power lines or parking near other vehicles with any of the above devices in them can also cause interference to your radio. Move your vehicle to see if your reception improves.

Finally, remember that local noise and interference only affects your ability to receive HF radio signals – it does not affect your transmissions. That means RAD1 and others will probably hear your transmissions perfectly but you may not be able to hear them. Even if you can't hear a reply, send your message anyway. If RAD1 can't hear you, RAD2 or another OV will often hear you and can pass your message on to RAD1.

Navigation – Ozi Explorer

Cheat Sheet

OziExplorer: OV's 'CHEAT SHEET' for common Bash uses:

(written as for OE Version 3.95.4i – menus may vary slightly with different versions)

NOTE: Assumes you can, or have, opened Ozi and acquired your current position using a GPS receiver/aerial and Moving Map. Also assumes you have the Plot (route) and Waypoint (track distance marker) files saved onto your PC and know their stored location (or you could be accessing the files from an external source like a flash drive or disc.)

Much of the instruction below utilises the pulldown menus. As with any software you may later find a toolbar button or another way to do the same thing a little quicker.

IMPORTANT: Before proceeding please check/change your coordinate setting to degrees & minutes/decimal minutes (RAD1 default).

Use the pulldown menu; File/Configuration, then the Maps tab and set the Lat/Long Display to Deg, Min. Save and Exit config.

- b) path to the file location and pick the required file – "daytwoam" or "2018day1pm" etc.
- c) b) Pick Open, the route should display on the screen as a coloured line.
- d) WAYPOINTS:
- e) c) From the pulldown menu; pick File/Load From File/Load Waypoints From File, then
- f) path to the file location (if necessary) and pick the required file.
- g) d) Pick Open, the Waypoints should display along the loaded route (Bash track) as elapsed
- h) distance markers at every 5km.

2. TO INPUT A POINT USING GIVEN COORDINATES (say from RAD1):

- a) Open Waypoint List from the pulldown menu; View/Lists/Waypoint List and then pick the
- b) Add button.
- c) Input the Name for the new point using a relevant one that you can recall later i.e; "Lost
- d) Car X", "New Lunch Location" or "RAD2test" etc.
- e) Input the given co-ordinates, tabbing between boxes. Be careful! Check Latitude is set

- f) to S (South). Longitude should be E (Easting). Co-ordinates given will be in degrees and minutes/decimal minutes i.e.; lat. 34d 37.02' S, long. 138d 28.14' E
- g) Pick on Save and then Close the Waypoint List dialogue box.

3. TO NAVIGATE TO A SAVED WAYPOINT (continuation of 2. above):

- a) From the pulldown menu; call up Navigation/Navigate To>/Waypoint From A List and select the required waypoint from the list. Pick Set. Moving Map should show a direct line from your current location to the Waypoint.
- b) If the point is off the current screen and you need to scroll or pan to look at it, stop the screen 'jumping back' by turning off Automatically Scroll Map via the pulldown menu; Moving Map/Automatically Scroll Map (has a tick alongside when on)
- c) You will need to determine the best route to get to the desired location (waypoint), utilising the existing roads/tracks etc. shown on your map as you see them, but remember DO NOT GO AGAINST THE BASH TRACK DIRECTION.
- d) Before moving off in your vehicle turn Moving Map back on; via the pulldown menu - Moving Map/ Automatically Scroll Map (has a tick alongside when on). The screen (map) should jump back to your current location.
- e) Also before departing you may want to mark your current location with another saved Waypoint, in case you need to come back to it. Using the pulldown menu Map/Add Or Drag Map Object>/Waypoint. Pick your location on the screen and note the assigned Waypoint number. Turn Add Waypoint off using the same menu or you will continue to get Waypoints every time you touch the screen!

Lost Vehicle Instruction - Motion Computer

Step 1 Create a dummy waypoint

From the task bar, tap the "Wpt" icon. This is the yellow square with a 1 in it and Wpt written under it.



Wpt

Tap the pen on the screen near to your current location. Exact position is not important. This will create a waypoint

Return to the task bar and tap the Wpt icon again **(this is important!!)**

Step 2 Edit the waypoint

Double tap the pen on the dot of the waypoint you have created. This will open an information window.

Tap the pen on the "**name**" box. This will bring up the keyboard icon. Tap on the icon to open the keyboard on the screen.

Change name to "lost car 500" for example

Close the keyboard by tapping on the red X at the top right hand corner of the keyboard

Tap the pen on the "**Edit Position**" box

Using the same method, Tap on the **Long and Lat** boxes and change the coordinates to those given for the lost vehicle.

Once changed, tap the **save** button on the edit window (top right) then tap the **save** button on the waypoint properties window. (bottom right)

Step 3, Navigation

At the very top of the screen tap the word "**Navigation**"

Tap on "**Navigate to**". This will open a window to the right. Select "**Waypoint from a list**"

From the list, tap on "**Lost car 500**" to highlight. Tap on the "**select**" button then close the **list window** by tapping on the **red X** (top right hand corner)

You will now see a straight line from your location to the lost car location waypoint.

Lost Vehicle Instruction - Android

Press waypoint button. This is the yellow circle with cross hairs and a green cross in the bottom right quadrant.

Press main menu button. This is a square with 3 dots sided by 3 lines and a green arrow pointing upwards in the top right corner

Press: **Operation** → **Waypoints** → **Nearest waypoint list**

Select the waypoint you just created. It should be the top of the list. Its description will be the current date and time. It is also your current location.

From Waypoint Options select "Edit Properties".

Tap on the "Waypoint Name" window and change name to Lost Car 500 (eg)

Scroll up and press save. This will return you to the "Nearest Waypoint" screen.

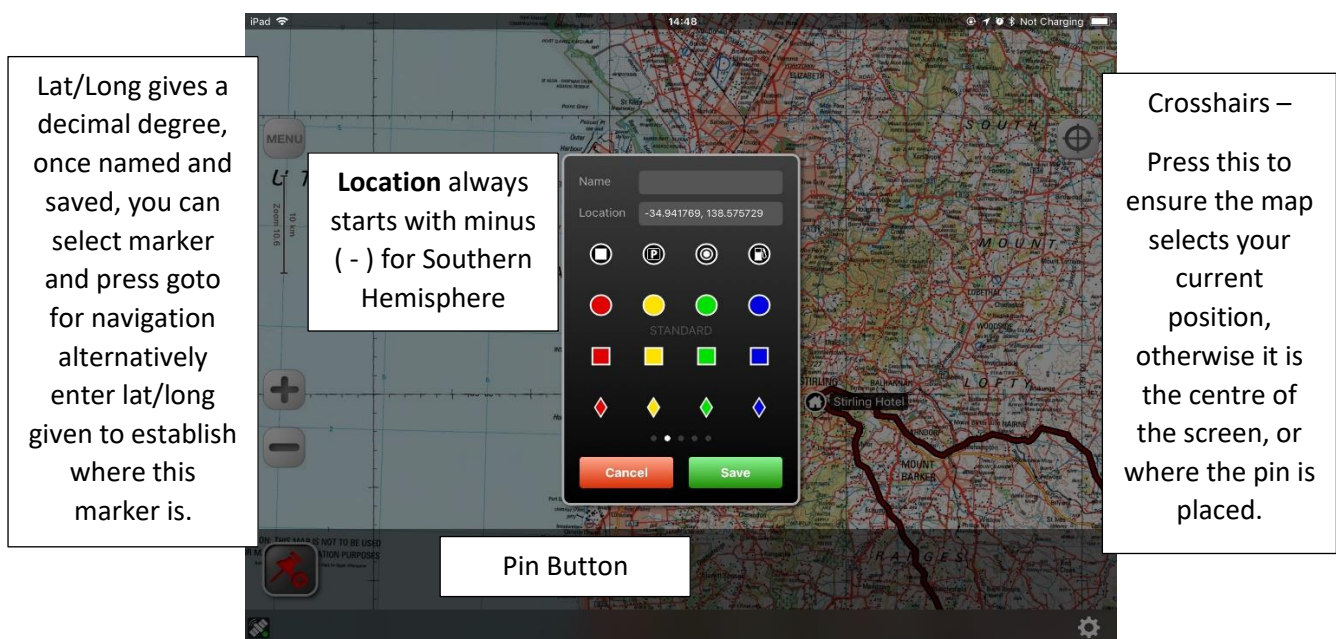

iPads must use a **2.4Amp** 12V Cigarette Plug with only a **Genuine Apple Lightning Cable**.

iPhones should use a minimum **1amp** 12V Cigarette Plug and **Genuine Apple Lightning Cable**.

Non Genuine Cables do not charge correctly and you will find the device will go flat over the course of the day even though it is charging. If this is the case try lowering screen brightness or turn off things like wifi, Bluetooth.

For Best Results use a Scorsche REVOLT USB charger available from Variety Office and your Genuine Cable

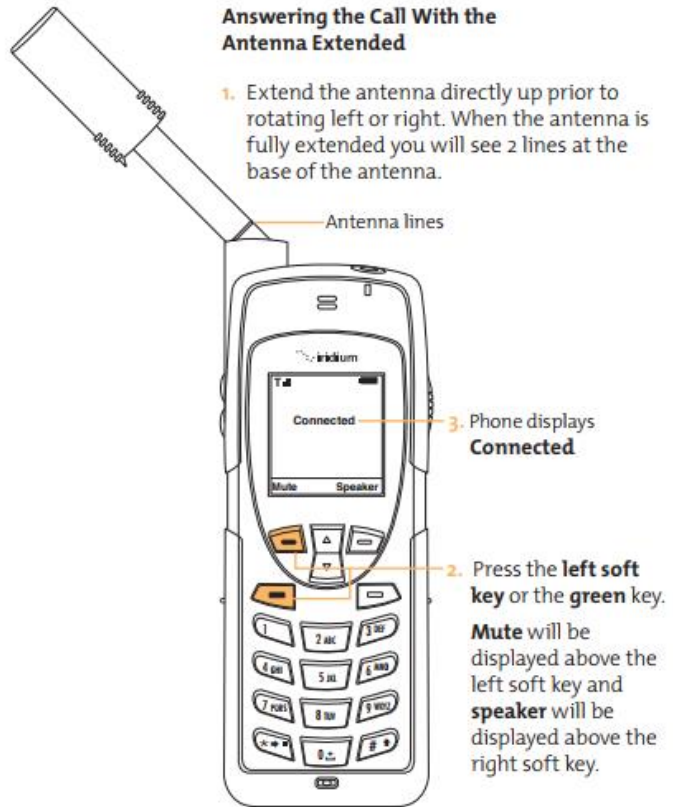

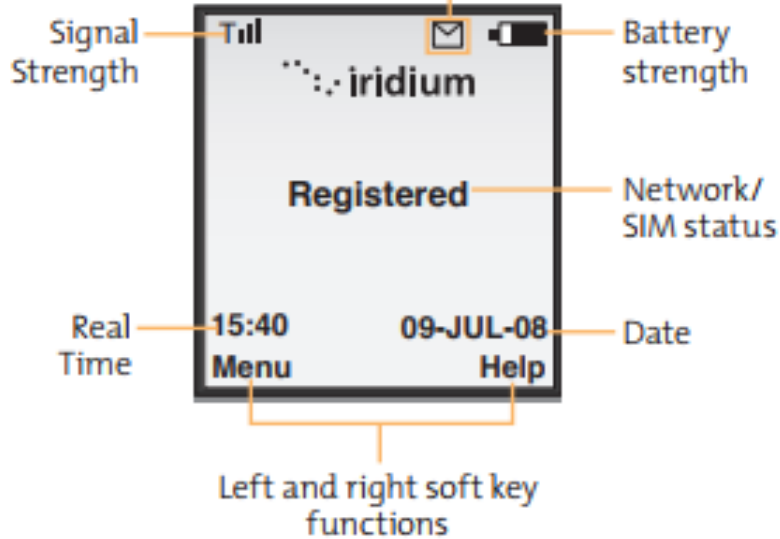

National Calls

To make a standard national call simply enter the area code and number – for example to call an interstate number eg. in Queensland simply dial 07 XXXX XXXX and to dial a standard national mobile number, including a call to another Pivotel Satellite number, simply dial 04 XX XXX XXX. You can also dial 13, 1300 and 1800 numbers just as they are advertised without any special codes to enter.

SMS Text Messages

You can send SMS text messages from your satellite phone to standard mobile numbers in Australia and overseas. To send a text message always enter the mobile number in the international format, for example an Australian mobile would be entered in the format +61 4XX XXX XXX.

Voicemail

For Pivot Plan subscribers, Pivotel provides a voicemail service so you need never miss a call. The voicemail number is +61424212121 – you can call this number from your satellite phone to setup your voicemail and then to retrieve your voicemail messages.

For Classic Casual customer's, voicemail is not supported. Instead callers can leave a short message that will be sent to the satellite phone as an SMS text message.

Press the *Menu* key (far left) to open the menu.

Using the Keypad

The *Menu* key cancels or goes back one level.

The *Up* key navigates up, or increases a value.

The *Down* key navigates down, or decreases a value.

The *Enter* key (far right) selects an option or confirms a setting.




Using the Touchpad

Swiping from top-to-bottom scrolls the menu up, while swiping bottom-to-top scrolls the menu down.

Touching a menu option selects that option.

Entering Values

When entering values, such as distances or the password, the keypad or touchscreen may be used. To enter a value using the keypad, you press *Up* or *Down* to change the current character/digit, *Enter* to progress to the next character/digit or *Menu* to go back one space. Pressing the screen enables an on-screen keypad/keyboard, which has the following three function keys:

-  Cancel
-  Backspace
-  Enter



Trip Configuration

The Trip Configuration menu allows the user to configure either of the trips.

Reset to 000.000

This option will reset the value of the selected trip to 0, or to the value set with the *Set Reset Value* option, below.

Load Value into Trip

This option allows the user to enter a value for the selected trip.

Set Reset Value

This option allows the user to change the reset value. When the selected trip is reset, either through this menu or through another function, it will be set to this value.

Trip Enabled

This option sets whether or not a trip is enabled and counting.

Trip Paused

This option sets whether or not a trip is paused. Exactly what happens when a trip is paused is configured in the *Pause Settings* menu.

Trip Runs

This option allows the user to choose whether the selected trip runs forwards or backwards.

GUIDELINES FOR MOBILE WORKSHOPS

Thank you for your most valued involvement in the SA Variety Bash.

The role of a Mobile Workshop is not the easiest of the Bash ... but should be both rewarding and enjoyable.

Your prime objective as a Mobile Workshop will be to ensure the survival and arrival of as many of Variety's Bashers as is humanly possible to Griffith.

The Bashers have worked long and hard to raise funds for the kids and from the commencement of the Bash it is the responsibility of the officials and yourselves to ensure that they achieve a fitting reward for their efforts.

You are obliged to check every stationary car en route to ascertain whether they are just resting ... or in need of your assistance.

Please use your discretion to assess each breakdown and determine whether the vehicle can be either:

1. Repaired on site. **Mechanical repairs must only be carried out by a qualified mechanic** from your Mobile Workshop team.
2. Towed to the nearest town or homestead. If towing or snatching a bogged vehicle with a snatch strap, ensure you use only rated D shackles as instructed
3. Remove from the road, and arrangements made to have the crew transported to the next stop and the vehicle recovered later by the crew.

You will be given copies of **Disclaimer Form mw3**. If you carry out a temporary repair to an entrant's Bash vehicle during the event, **you should**, prior to the entrant rejoining the Bash:

- Complete the Disclaimer form in duplicate;
- Inform the entrant that neither Variety SA nor the mobile workshop crew involved take any responsibility for the repair;
- Get the entrant to sign the Disclaimer; and
- Give the original of the Disclaimer to the entrant and keep the duplicate.

Please complete all parts of the form. An example of the type of comment under Brief Description of Work Carried Out is:

"The tie rod has been straightened to the best of our ability and it is suggested that the vehicle travel at not more than 10km per hour to the nearest township for replacement of part".

Official vehicles are also rostered for specific duties and should receive preferential treatment over entrants for mechanical repairs.

All Mobile Workshops should have rotating beacons and you are asked to use these when performing roadside repairs.

Mobile Workshops are rostered for "sweep" duty. As Sweep you are to collect all Bash signs and hand them to the next day's "Zero" Official Vehicle. Sweep must also ensure no vehicle is left stranded ... and this means Sweep is the last vehicle in each night. But ... there will be an Official Vehicle and crew waiting at the control point to greet you.
