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# Licenses

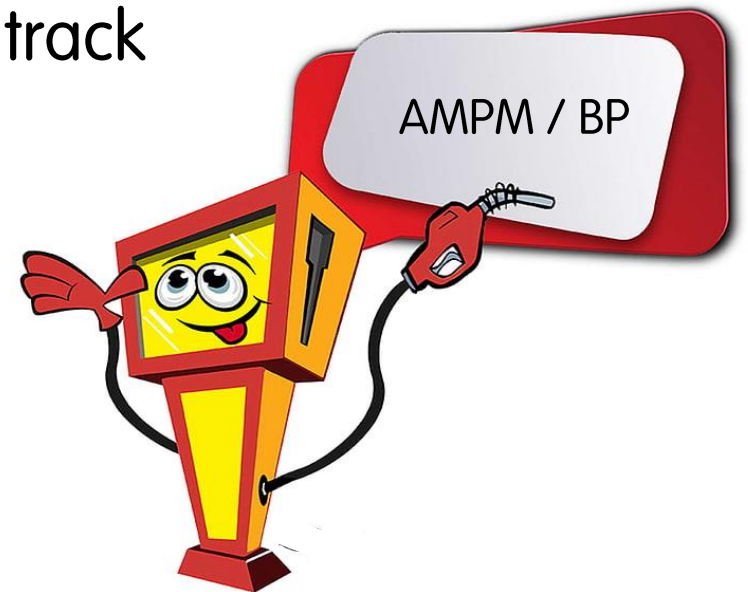


- We are close to finalising with Motorsport Australia and will advise as soon as possible.
