Terms & Conditions of Entry

1. General Information

- 1.1 Information on how to enter and prize details form part of these conditions. Entry into this competition is deemed acceptance of these terms and conditions of entry.

- 3.2 A maximum of one (1) entry is allowed per Eligible Entrant.
- 3.3 If the contestant is under 18, a parent/legal guardian must enter on behalf of the Eligible Entrant.
- 3.4 All Eligible Entrants must be available to attend:
 - 3.4.1 Possible Ch 9 live cross, Nine Perth studio, 6.00-9.00am Friday 15 December 2017
 - 3.4.2 Sound check at a time TBC between 10.00am-12.00pm, Langley Park, Sunday 17 December 2017.
 - 3.4.3 Carols show performance, 6.30pm-9.30pm, Langley Park, Sunday 17 December 2017.

4. How to Apply

- 4.1 To enter the competition, an Eligible Entrant must submit a valid application before 3pm WST, Friday, 8 December 2017.
- 4.2 Valid applications must include a video recording containing:
 - 4.2.1 A message telling how performing helps you to Act-Belong-Commit.
 - 4.2.2 A live performance singing "Deck the Halls" (an excerpt is acceptable). Performance may be accompanied by live instrument, instrumental backing track or acapella.
- 4.3 Entry into the competition is free.

5. Prize

- 5.1 The winner of the 2017 Act Belong Commit Carols Star competition will win the following performance opportunities at the 2017 IGA Carols by Candlelight for Variety on Sunday 17 December:
